



Tickets fly for joint summer business BBQ

The Dorset Junior Chamber (DJC) is anticipating a sell out for their summer BBQ this year, as the annual event will be run in conjunction with the Bournemouth Chamber of Trade and Commerce to coincide with the Bournemouth Air Festival. The networking groups have secured the best seat in the house for the high profile Festival, as the afternoon event will be held at the Cumberland Hotel on Friday 21st August 2009.

As one of the aims of the DJC is to facilitate links amongst all of Dorset's networking groups, this is a positive example. The event has been designed as to act as a social business occasion where positive relationships can be built against the backdrop of the hugely popular Air Festival.
